

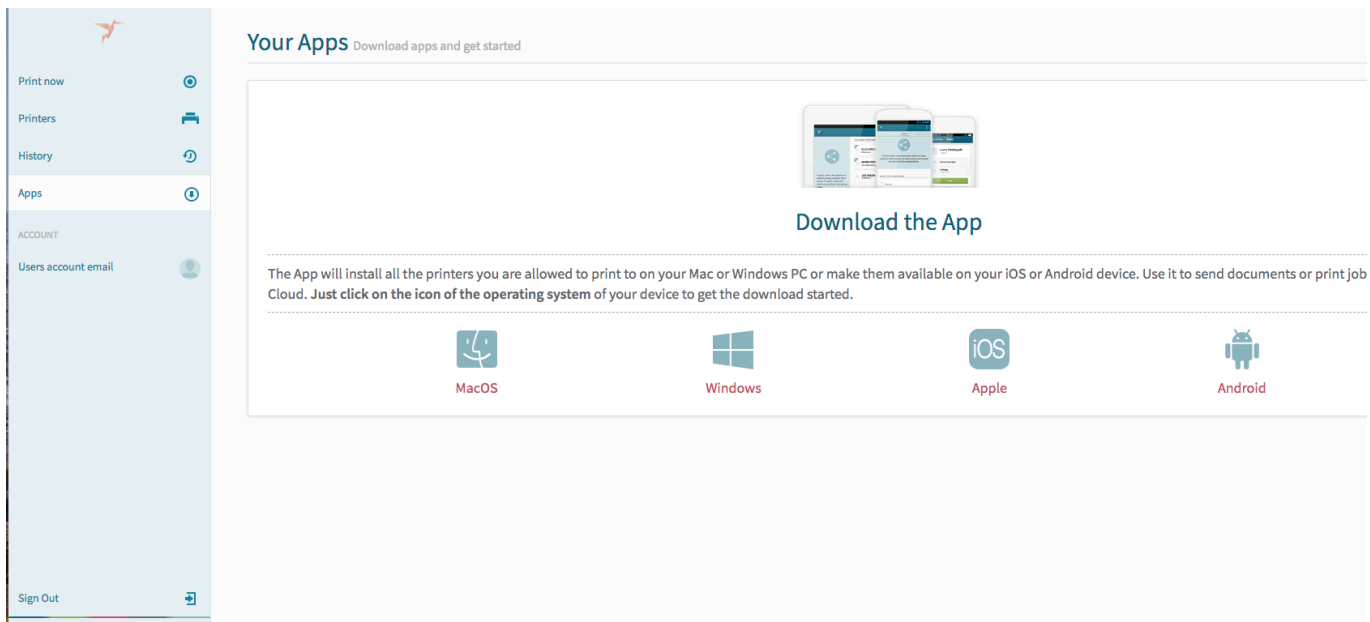
## How to Print with ezeep on a Mac

Great news! You have been invited to use ezeep by your organization. The password has been set and you can print using the Web Portal. That's awesome.

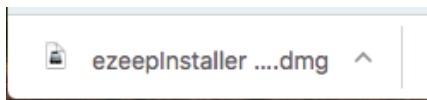
Wouldn't it be great if you could just print like you normally did with your Mac? Printing straight from an application to your network printer? Oh wait, **You can** do this with ezeep.

Install the ezeep Mac app by downloading from here: <https://www.ezeep.com/wp-content/uploads/packages/osx/stable/ezeepInstaller.dmg>

Or you can click on your Apps tab in your ezeep portal and selecting the "MacOS" option.

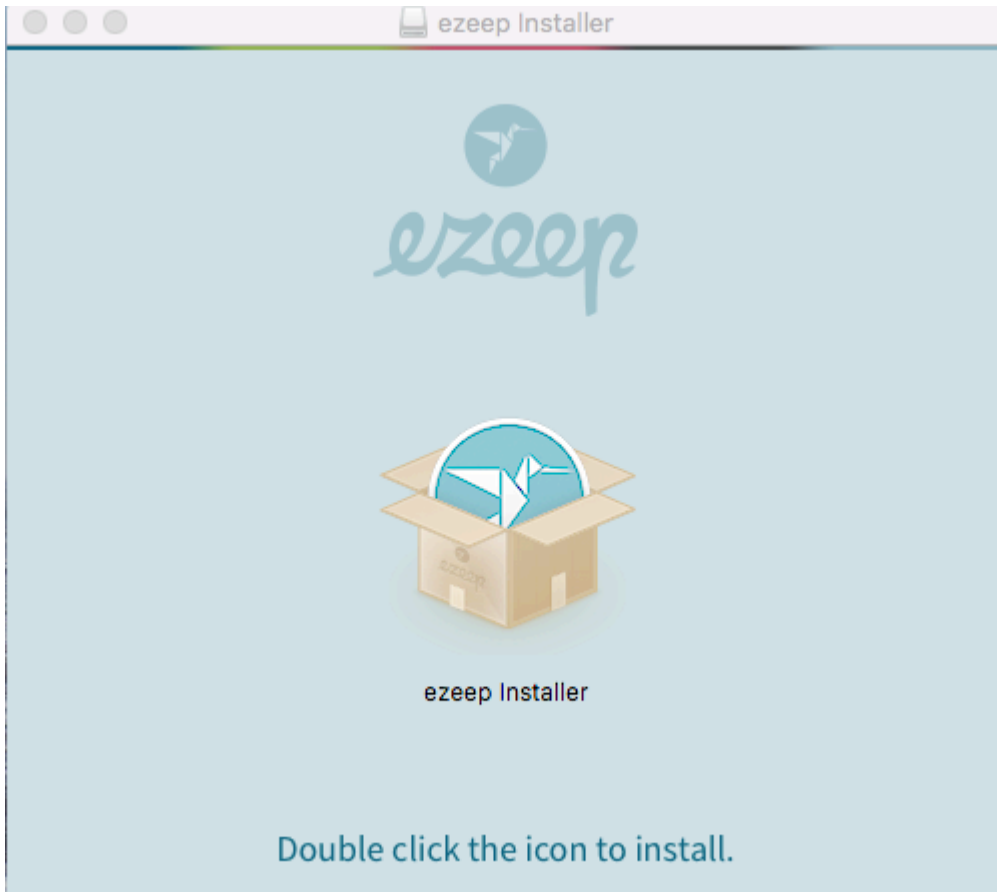


Click on the "ezeepInstaller.dmg" at the bottom of your browser. (you can find this in your Download folder, in the Finder as well)



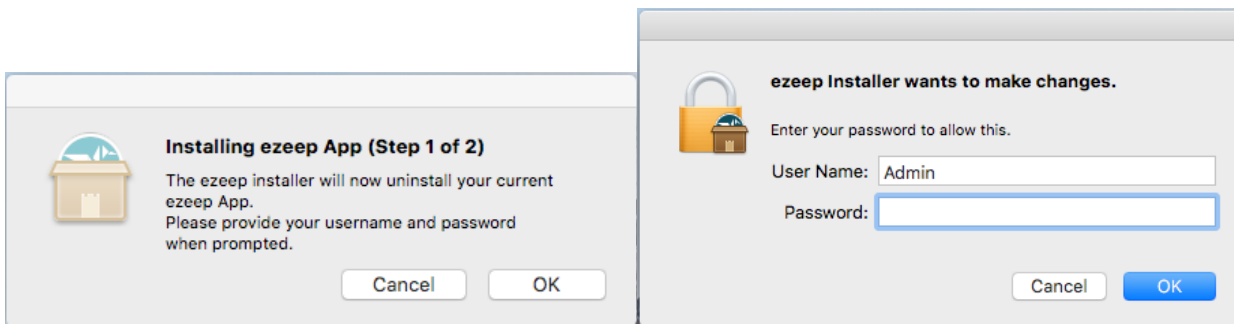
Follow the directions through the installation. You will need your administrative ID and Password for your Mac.

Double Click on the Icon in the middle of the popup screen.



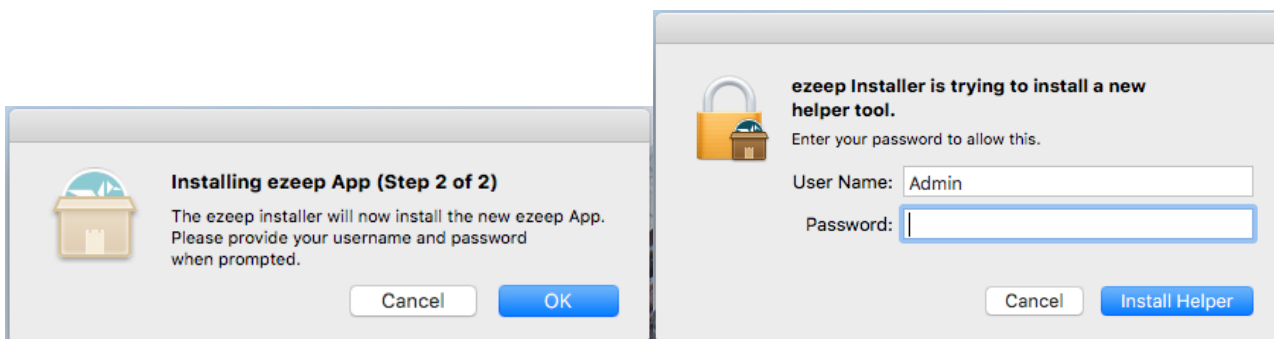
Click "ok" to install Step 1 of 2.

You will need your administrator's ID and PW for your Mac here and then click "ok"

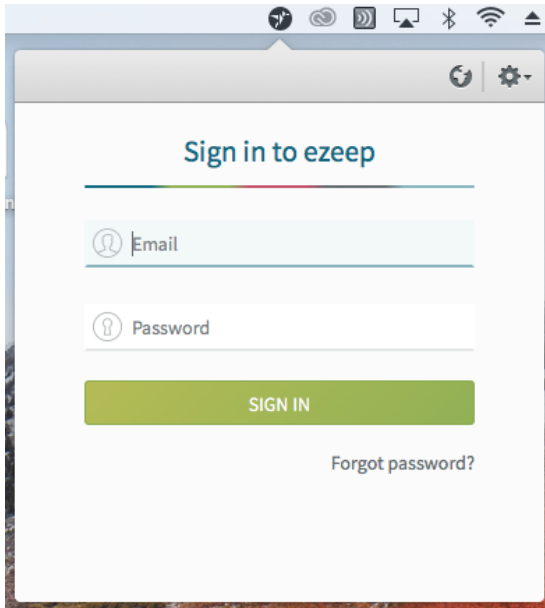


Click "ok" to Install step 2 of 2

Then you will need to enter your administrator's ID and PW for this "Helper tool"



Sign in to the ezeep app

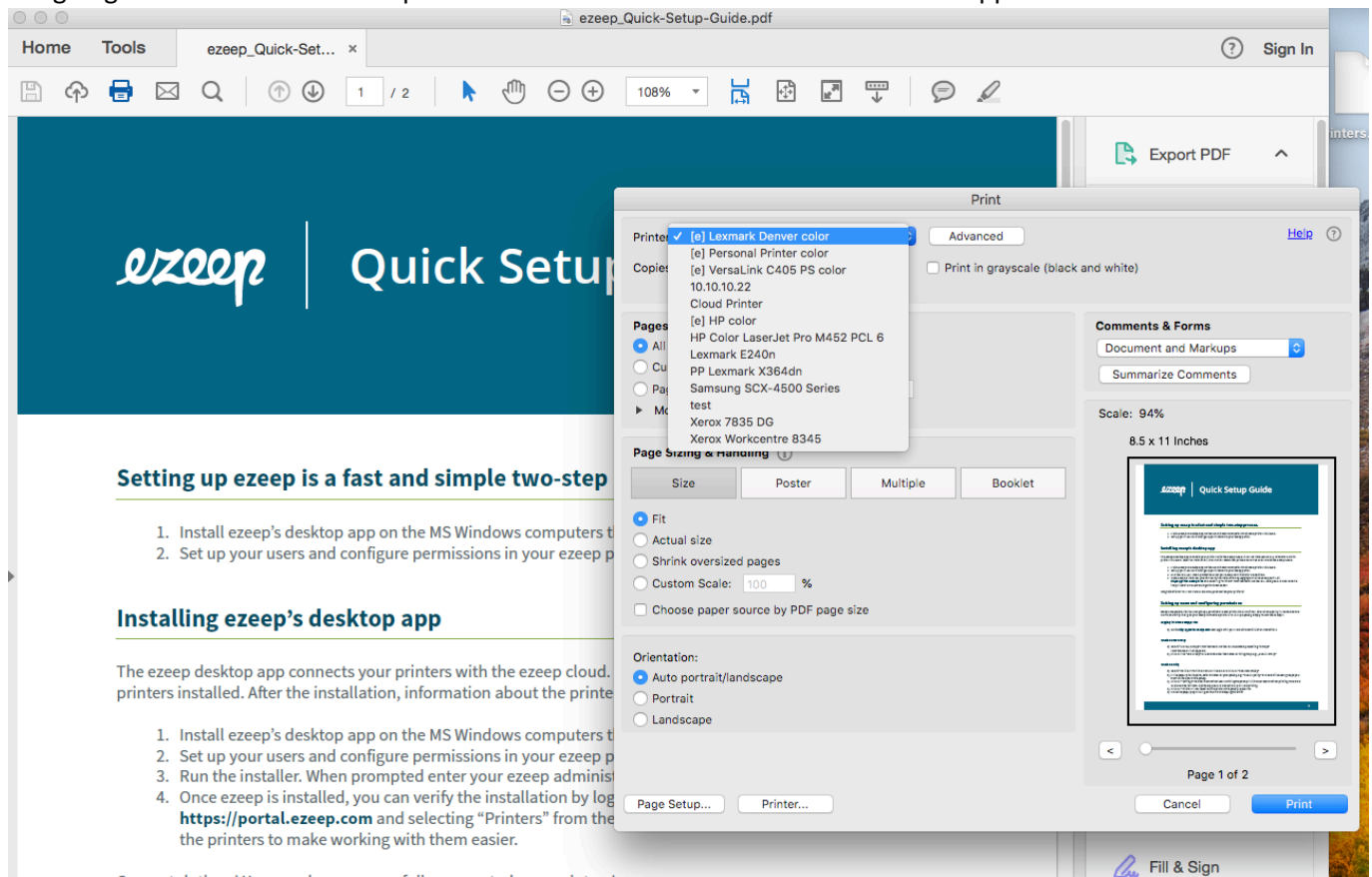


Then the app will be running and you will know it by the Humming Bird icon on the top right of your screen.



Now Let's get to printing in your apps.

I'm going to use a PDF. I have it open and click on Print or the Printer Icon in the app.



When you see your “printer” area click on it to reveal all of your printers.

You can see that all the (e) ezeep printers are listed here.

Select the one that you would like to print to and click on the Print button.

Just like that, you are printing like you always have been but through the cloud app using ezeep.
